
SKILL: SPEAKING

LEVEL: A1–A2

PART I: Join in groups of 3.

How to Play:

- a) Each group gets a board, dice, and markers.
- b) Players take turns rolling the dice and moving their marker.
- c) When a player lands on a number, they answer a speaking question about habits or routines using a frequency adverb.
- d) If they land on a ladder, they move up. If they land on a snake, they go down!
- e) The first player to reach the last square wins!

PART II: Frequency Adverbs Chain Game.

How to Play:

Sit in a circle. Each one says a sentence with a frequency adverb, and the next student repeats it and adds a new sentence.

- Example: **Student 1:** I usually wake up early. **Student 2:** I usually wake up early. **Student 3:** I sometimes eat breakfast late...

PART III: Survey & Report

Ask classmates about different activities, collect answers, and then present the survey results using frequency adverbs to the class.

Follow the next questions:

- 1- How often do you eat tortillas for breakfast?
- 2- How often do you go to the market?
- 3- How often do you listen to marimba music?
- 4- How often do you visit your grandparents?
- 5- How often do you play soccer with friends?

Examples of presenting survey results:

- Luis always eats tortillas for breakfast.
- María sometimes goes to the market.
